Nomination deadline	April 30 th for the next academic year (winter and/or spring semester)
Application deadline	May 15 th for the next academic year (winter and/or spring semester) The application guidelines will be sent to the student after the nomination.
Study programme	Single-cycle Master Degree Study Programme Veterinary Medicine
Requirements for admission	UL VF accepts foreign students of veterinary medicine from their 3 rd year onwards.
Language requirements	Courses are taught in Slovene with individual consultations with the lecturer in English. Exchange students can take exams in English. The level of students' Slovene or English language proficiency must be at least B2 on the CEFR scale of the European Language Portfolio Levels.
Course selection	Nominated students will receive UL VF's course catalogue (curriculum) for the next academic year. The syllabuses of particular courses are available to nominated students on demand. Exchange students may only choose courses from UL VF's 3 rd , 4 th , 5 th or 6 th year of study. As a rule, they may only choose courses from one year of study, unless they also need to attend specific courses which are mandatory at their home institutions and offered in other years at UL VF.

	Students are advised that timetable issues may occur when choosing courses from different years as their courses might overlap. Exchange students may only choose UL VF's practical/clinical courses if they have acquired sufficient theoretical knowledge on the subject at their home institutions.
