<b>Nomination deadline</b>	May 15 <sup>th</sup> for the next academic year (winter and/or spring semester)
<b>Application deadline</b>	May 31 <sup>st</sup> for the next academic year (winter and/or spring semester) The application guidelines will be sent to the student after the nomination.
<b>Study programme</b>	Single-cycle Master Degree Study Programme Veterinary Medicine
<b>Requirements for admission</b>	UL VF accepts foreign students of veterinary medicine from their 3 <sup>rd</sup> year onwards.
<b>Language requirements</b>	Courses are taught in Slovene with individual consultations with the lecturer in English. Exchange students can take exams in English. The level of students' Slovene or English language proficiency must be at least B2 on the CEFR scale of the European Language Portfolio Levels.
<b>Course selection</b>	The course catalogue for 2021/2022 can be found <a href="#">here</a> . As a rule, exchange students may only choose courses from one year of study (3 <sup>rd</sup> , 4 <sup>th</sup> , 5 <sup>th</sup> or 6 <sup>th</sup> ), unless they also need to attend specific courses which are mandatory at their home institution and offered in other years at UL VF. Students are advised that timetable issues may occur when choosing courses from other years as their courses might overlap. The syllabuses of particular courses are available to exchange students on demand.
